Saturday 25th of September 2010 from 9am to 5pm

- Entries have to be received at least two weeks before the exhibition. Entries close on the 10th of September 2010. Photos can be dropped off to the Photo Place in Morrisons Arcade, Harvey Norman South Nowra, and B&K Camera House in Junction Street. There is a \$5.00 entry fee; please post entry fee and entry form to Troy Pocock Meningococcal Foundation at P.O Box 419 Nowra NSW 2541.
- There are four categories this year 1. Portrait of a Person 2. Animal \Creature 3. Landscape\Seascape 4.Sport and Action. You can only enter four photographs maximum, so there is plenty of room to have everybody' s images on display. For example: you can enter one photograph in each section. Please put details and the title of your photograph on the back of your images please.
- Photographs have to be a minimum size of 8x12 Inches or larger NO SMALLER THAN 8X12(THEY WONT BE EXCEPTED) and all photos matte mounted NOT framed.\$5.00 entry fee for each photograph which will go to the foundation to continue their awareness campaign into the deadly meningococcal disease. Exhibits may be sold with the foundation taking a sales commission of 15%.
- The Exhibition is open to any photographer; photographs must be taken in the last 12 months.
